It is understood that I/we will have no rights to information regarding the adoption or whereabouts of this dog. Any information or contact with the adopting party will be at the sole discretion and initiation of the adopting party.

I/We understand that euthanasia may be considered as a final alternative to adoption if this dog is found to have a temperament problem or behavioral condition that is potentially dangerous or prohibits GBGRR from responsibly placing it in an adoptive home or a chronic, irreversible medical condition that significantly affects the dog's quality of life (in the opinion of a licensed and board certified veterinarian) or that GBGRR feels is beyond its capability to physically or financially care for.

I/We agree to provide GBGRR with any documents and available information concerning this dog to assist in placing our dog in the appropriate foster and adoptive home, including health and shot records, pedigree and AKC records (if applicable), training records and certificates (if applicable), name and address of breeder or other person from whom our dog was acquired, microchip registration information (if applicable) and any and all other information regarding this dog's history, character and individual personality traits. Authorization is granted to obtain our dog's health records from any veterinarian or vet clinic.

By executing this document, I/we certify that this dog has never bitten any human being. I/We further warrant and guarantee to GBGRR that this dog's history with regards to biting, growling or any other act of aggression has been accurately described above. I/We understand that should determination ever be made that the biting/growling/aggression history of this dog be proven to have been misrepresented by the owner or relinquisher, the owner and/or relinquisher will then be solely responsible for any and all court costs, attorneys fees, and medical/surgical bills resulting from owner's and/or relinquisher's misrepresentation of the dog's prior history.

I/We understand this profile, release and the policies described above and agree to their conditions. I/We agree to hold GBGRR, its officers, board members and all other volunteers harmless for any loss, damage, or injury to persons, animals or property arising from or relating to the placement of this dog. I/We are relinquishing said dog of my/our own free will and not under duress of any kind.
